How Much Mess?

The short answer is: Not much! We really stay on top of the mess so that it never gets out of hand, and never leave any birth mess for you to take care of.

Birth Mess Fun Facts:

Total average blood loss is 2 cups.

Total average amniotic fluid volume is 1.5 quarts.

Most of the "mess" happens with the birth. There is usually very little mess during labor.

To control the mess we:

- Are very liberal with absorbent underpads, a.k.a "chux" pads and plastic tarps.
- Wipe up all other drips right away.
- Place all trash immediately into trash bags.
- Use black trash bags to help minimize the appearance of bloody chux and other things.
- Put all dirty laundry in a large laundry basket as we go.
